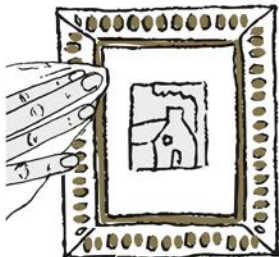
Annie Sloan Gilding Wax

directly onto plaster or wood.



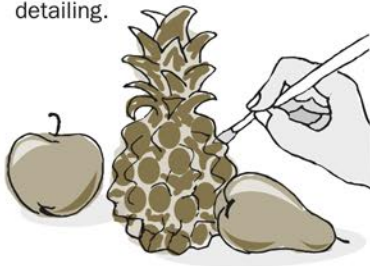

Getting Started

Squeeze a small amount of Gilding Wax onto a lint-free cloth or fine brush. A little goes a long way, so start sparingly. Gently apply the Gilding Wax onto the surface, allowing some of the paint below to show through; this creates a distressed look. For a denser coverage, add a little more Gilding Wax. If you apply too much, don't worry, simply remove it by wiping on a little Clear Chalk Paint® Wax with a clean, lint-free cloth. Leave to cure overnight then buff the following day to remove excess pigment.



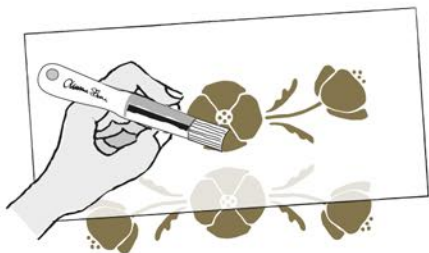
Apply to ornate carvings and mouldings to enhance texture and detailing.



Try painting decorative papier mâché or plaster objects with Chalk Paint® then apply Gilding Wax to highlight the shape and texture.

Mix and match Gilding Wax colours to create contrast.

On smooth furniture or walls, create Gilding Wax designs using your favourite Annie Sloan Stencil.



Our Gilding Wax has concentrated metallic colour for extended coverage – in every tube there's enough wax to cover a standard dining room chair. (Approx 1.7 m² or 18 Ft²)
